

**Letter from MMA Workers Comp Audit**

**Re: the letter from the Town Attorney** regarding the inquiry from John Edgecomb about Huff's Mill Rd., the Selectmen asked Clyde to write a letter to Mr. Edgecomb defining the Town Attorney's opinion, which basically was that the Town would not be able to grant an easement on a road which had reverted back to abutters, except by taking the property by eminent domain. Clyde will also advise Mr. Edgecomb that he will be billed for the Town Attorney's cost for this opinion.
