


**Audience Participation**

**Tom Garrepy was in.** He said engine 6 failed inspection and is out of service. He said there were electrical problems, and it failed the pump test. He will look into selling it. Roy suggested a price of \$2500.

Tom asked if we have received a check of \$585.00 which is due us because of an arson case which the Fire Dept responded to last Fall. Carol said we haven't seen it yet.

Tom told the Selectmen that Maxam has built a 5000 gal incinerator container to burn their packaging as they are required by law. He said the DEP will inspect this. Also, he said we will be getting a bill from the fire department which is about \$7800. He said the money to pay for this was received from a grant in 2009.

**Justin Keleher, Recreation Director,** brought in a bill for uniforms. He told the Selectmen that he would like to use some money for dugouts. He said the money would be just for materials. Volunteers will be doing the labor. He said the materials would be about \$3000. The Bowdoin Recreation will be hosting a

tournament there in June. We will be starting concessions, which should bring in some more money to the Department. We now have about 53 enrolled in baseball and 30 in softball.

**Carolyn Napoleon**, who owns property on Goodenow Lane, asked the Selectmen who owns Goodenow Lane. She said there are problems with people speeding up and down the road on ATV vehicles. The Selectmen said the road should have been turned over to residents of the subdivision, but apparently this was never done. They told her, unfortunately the Town is unable to do anything for her. Her only option is to try to work it out with her neighbors and/or Cindy Goodenow.

**Junior Card** told the Board he will need to close Lewis Hill Road on Friday, April 23rd, between 8 AM and 2:00 PM.. The Selectmen told Carol to call Sagadahoc Dispatch Center and advise them that the road will be closed between Box 823 and Box 875. Junior said he would put up signs at Hix Small Cemetery Road. He has notified Tom Garrepy, Fire Chief.

**Clyde Cavender** asked if attached garages should be assessed lower than detached ones. Roy said yes.
