

Old Business:

Roy asked **Clyde** to get him a copy of the ruling on discontinued roads.

John made a motion to add "the Contractor covenants to hold the town harmless," to all snow plowing and sanding contracts. Marc seconded and vote was 3-0 in favor.

Marc made a motion to change the liability insurance requirements on the Plowing contract for Municipal lots to \$100,000. Roy seconded. Vote was 3-0 in favor.

Clyde Pratt came in at the request of the Selectmen. He said when they removed the culvert on Starbird Corner Rd it caused water to back up on his property, so he dug a ditch to stop it.

The Selectmen told him he needs to make the road passable because it is a public right of way. Roy told him the rocks are too close to the road.

Marc asked him if he would put in the culvert if we get a used one. He said yes.

The selectmen asked JR Card about a used culvert. JR said he has a 20 foot culvert which he will take over there.

The Selectmen asked Carol to have Melanie come in next Monday night.

The ad will go into the paper this week for Plowing and Sanding contracts.

Marc suggested that we should have bids for all 4 sections of road before we open bids, in fairness to the bidders.

Clyde Cavender told the Selectmen that Val Mann will do changes to the maps for less than \$1000. Marc made a motion to accept her proposal, John seconded and the vote was 3-0 in favor.
